

Introduction:

- Most people who are believers are interested in the revelatory realm.
- What do we mean by revelatory realm. We mean walking with God in such a way that we are getting revelation about Him for our lives.
 - I pray...*"that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him,"* (Ephesians 1:17, NKJV) That is the revelatory realm.
 - Prophetic words, dreams, visions, words of wisdom and knowledge. All are a part of the revelatory realm.
- The question so many have is this: "How do I get into the revelatory realm?"
- For most people you have got to want it. That is where the seeking begins.

I. The Sovereign Entrance this is where God just does something to reveal himself.

- A. God's sovereign movement. This is considered God's doing. I am doing nothing to make this happen.
 1. Sovereign - one who holds all power and authority. God's doing.
 2. There are some things that God has set up or established to be.
 - a) God chooses people
 - (1) Abraham - Abram hears God to go to land he has never been to and is given the promise of being the father of many nations. God just did that.
 - (2) Moses - Moses at the burning bush. That was a revelatory realm! Ex 3:4-5 "Moses! Take your shoes off you are standing on holy ground." That is revelation!!! Holy Ground, voice of God!
 - (3) John the Baptist - He is written in the Book. IS. 40:3 *"Voice crying in the wilderness."*
- B. These God moments are Kairos - moments, God appointed times and plans.
 1. Usually birthed in intercession.
 - a) Children of Israel cried out.
 - b) Hannah interceded for Samuel.
 - c) Elijah travailed to break a drought.
 - d) Jesus travailed for cross and resurrection.
 2. Means being in the right place at the right time.
- C. So there are sovereign doors into the revelatory realm. These do not occur often.

II. The Spiritual Entrance - then we have the spiritual entrance into the revelatory realm.

- A. In the Spirit has to do with living a quality spiritual life. This is done out of obedience, discipline and joy. It is 'doing the commands' out of love not works. I'm not trying to earn something from God.
- B. John the Apostle: *"It was the Lord's Day, and I was worshiping in the Spirit. Suddenly, I heard behind me a loud voice like a trumpet blast."* (Revelation 1:10, NLT)
 1. It was the Lords day. John was honoring the day of rest, the Sabbath. Jesus did not do away with the Sabbath. He wanted it kept the right way. Remember mercy!
 2. John was worshipping. It wasn't just another day. It was a Sabbath and worship was a part of the Sabbath. Not that you did not worship the rest of the week...this was an appointed time...enter His rest.
 - a) Worship takes you into the revelatory realm. The realm of the Spirit is the revelatory realm.

- (1) *"But the time is coming—indeed it's here now—when true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and in truth. The Father is looking for those who will worship him that way. For God is Spirit, so those who worship him must worship in spirit and in truth."* (John 4:23-24, NLT)
- (2) David was a man after God's own heart. *"But now your kingdom must end, for the Lord has sought out a man after his own heart. The Lord has already appointed him to be the leader of his people, because you have not kept the Lord's command."* (1 Samuel 13:14, NLT) Also 16:12-13*** David is anointed.
- (3) David created the Tabernacle of David - night and day prayer 24/7. Loved God/loved worship/and loved giving Him glory.
- b) Worship attracts God.
 - (1) *"But You are holy, Enthroned in the praises of Israel."* (Psalm 22:3, NKJV)
 - (2) 2 Kings 3:9-19, Elisha - requests a musician.
 - (3) Acts 13:1-ff. As they worshiped God spoke!
 - (4) Rev 19:1-5. Saints worship and God speaks. From the throne comes a voice.
- c) Kelly and I saw angels while worshipping. 1981.
- C. Suddenly - suddenlies happen in worship!

III. Walk in the Spiritual Entrance

- A. To walk in the spirit means to journey with God. Enoch walked with God and He was not. Noah walked with God. He is a part of the 'entire day' of our lives. Phil 2:1 Speaks of the fellowship of the Spirit—communing with God.
 - 1. Prayer - God loves it when we talk with Him.
 - 2. In the Word - Jn 6:63 the Word is Spirit and Life. That is supernatural. That is the revelatory realm. God talking...communicating with us.
 - 3. In Meditation -
- B. *"If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit."* (Galatians 5:25, NKJV)
- C. *"For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death."* (Romans 8:2, NKJV)
- D. *"If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit."* (Galatians 5:25, NKJV)
- E. *"And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption."* (Ephesians 4:30, NKJV)

IV. We Enter By Faith

- A. We operate in the gifts through faith. They are not earned. They are not deserved.
- B. Everything from God comes by faith. Not luck, not chance, it comes by faith.
 - 1. Your faith has made your well.
 - 2. Last week we looked at Mt. 16:16-18. Jesus says to Peter, "You are blessed for this has been revealed to you by my Father in heaven. That takes faith!...to have a thought...and to speak that thought!
 - 3. Hebrews 11 is all about the faith! By faith...and the rest are the stories.
 - 4. What will be your story?
