Jesus is Lord over my spirit, my soul, and my body

Phil 2:9-11 → Therefore [because He stooped so low] God has highly exalted Him and has [a]freely bestowed on Him the name that is above every name, that in (at) the name of Jesus every knee [b]should (must) bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue [c]frankly and openly] confess and acknowledge that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Jesus has been made unto me wisdom, righteousness, sanctification and redemption. I have wisdom from God for all activities of life. I can do all things through Christ Who strengthens me. Jesus has infused me with inner strength.

I Cor 1:30 → But it is from Him that you have your life in Christ Jesus, Whom God made our Wisdom from God, [revealed to us a knowledge of the divine plan of salvation previously hidden, manifesting itself as] our Righteousness [thus making us upright and putting us in right standing with God], and our Consecration [making us pure and holy], and our Redemption [providing our ransom from eternal penalty for sin].

Phil 4:13 → I have strength for all things in Christ Who empowers me [I am ready for anything and equal to anything through Him Who infuses inner strength into me; I am self-sufficient in Christ's sufficiency].

James 1:5 → If any of you is deficient in wisdom, let him ask of [a]the giving God [Who gives] to everyone liberally and ungrudgingly, without reproaching or faultfinding, and it will be given him.

Prov 2:6 For the Lord gives skillful and godly Wisdom; from His mouth come knowledge and understanding

1 Peter 2:24 → He personally bore our sins in His [own] body on the tree [^a][as on an altar and offered Himself on it], that we might die (cease to exist) to sin and live to righteousness. By His wounds you have been healed.

1 Cor 6:20 → You were bought with a price [purchased with a ^a]preciousness and paid for, [^b]made His own]. So then, honor God and bring glory to Him in your body.

I have the mind of Christ and hold the thoughts, feelings, and purposes of His heart

1 Cor 2:16 → For who has known or understood the mind (the counsels and purposes) of the Lord so as to guide and instruct Him and give Him knowledge? But we have the mind of Christ (the Messiah) and do hold the thoughts (feelings and purposes) of His heart.

I am a believer and not a doubter. I hold fast to my confession of faith. I decide to walk by faith and practice faith. My faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God. Jesus is the author and developer / finisher of my faith

Heb 4:14 → Inasmuch then as we have a great High Priest Who has [already] ascended and passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession [of faith in Him].

Heb 11:6 → But without faith it is impossible to please and be satisfactory to Him. For whoever would come near to God must [necessarily] believe that God exists and that He is the rewarder of those who earnestly and diligently seek Him [out].

Rom 10:17 → So faith comes by hearing [what is told], and what is heard comes by the preaching [of the message that came from the lips] of Christ (the Messiah Himself).

Heb 12:2 → Looking away [from all that will distract] to Jesus, Who is the Leader and the Source of our faith [giving the first incentive for our belief] and is also its Finisher [bringing it to maturity and perfection]. He, for the joy [of obtaining the prize] that was set before Him, endured the cross, despising and ignoring the shame, and is now seated at the right hand of the throne of God.

Ex 14:13 → Moses told the people, Fear not; stand still (firm, confident, undismayed) and see the salvation of the Lord which He will work for you today. For the Egyptians you have seen today you shall never see again.

Job 37:14-15 → Hear this, O Job; stand still and consider the wondrous works of God. Do you know how God lays His command upon them and causes the lightning of His [storm] cloud to shine?

Isa 26:3-4 → You will guard him and keep him in perfect and constant peace whose mind [both its inclination and its character] is stayed on You, because he commits himself to You, leans on You, and hopes confidently in You. So trust in the Lord (commit yourself to Him, lean on Him, hope confidently in Him) forever; for the Lord God is an everlasting Rock [the Rock of Ages].

for us. God is love, and he who dwells and continues in love dwells and continues in God, and God dwells and continues in him.

I John 5:18 → We know [absolutely] that anyone born of God does not [deliberately and knowingly] practice committing sin, but the One Who was begotten of God carefully watches over and protects him [Christ's divine presence within him preserves him against the evil], and the wicked one does not lay hold (get a grip) on him or touch [him].

I tread upon serpents and scorpions and over the power of the enemy. I take my shield of faith and quench his every fiery dart. Greater is He that is in me than he that is in the world. God is on my side. I am a world overcomer because I am born of God.

Rom 8:31 → What then shall we say to [all] this? If God is for us, who [can be] against us? [Who can be our foe, if God is on our side?]

I John 5:4,5 → For whatever is born of God is victorious over the world; and this is the victory that conquers the world, even our faith. Who is it that is victorious over [that conquers] the world but he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God [who adheres to, trusts in, and relies on that fact]?

 Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as you have: for he has said, I will never leave you, nor forsake you. So that we may boldly say, The Lord is my helper, and I will not fear what man shall do unto me. Hebrews 13:5, 6
 There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear has torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love. 1 John 4:18
 Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world. 1 John 4:4
 He that overcometh shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son. But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burns with fire and brimstone: which is the second death. Revelation 21:7, 8
 Psalm 91 1He that dwells in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. 2I will say of the LORD, He is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in him will I trust. 3Surely he shall deliver you from the snare of the fowler, and from the noisome pestilence. 4He shall cover you with his feathers, and under his wings shall you trust: his truth shall be thy shield and buckler. 5You shall not be afraid for the terror by night; nor for the arrow that flies by day; 6Nor for the pestilence that walks in darkness; nor for the destruction that wasted at noonday. 7A thousand shall fall at thy side, and ten thousand at thy right hand; but it shall not come nigh you. 8Only with your eyes shall you behold and see the reward of the wicked. 9Because you hast made the LORD, which is my refuge, even the most High, thy habitation; 10There shall no evil befall you, neither shall any plague come nigh thy dwelling. 11For he shall give his angels charge over you, to keep you in all thy ways. 12They shall bear you up in their hands, lest you dash thy foot against a stone. 13You shall tread upon the lion and adder: the young lion and the dragon shall you trample under feet. 14Because he has set his love upon me, therefore will I deliver him: I will set him on high, because he has known my name. 15He shall call upon me, and I will answer him: I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honor him. 16With long life will I satisfy him, and show him my salvation.

I represent the Father and Jesus well. I am a useful member in the body of Christ. I am His workmanship recreated in Christ Jesus. My Father God is all the while effectually at work in me both to will and do His good pleasure.

Eph 2:10 → For we are God's [own] handiwork (His workmanship), [a]recreated in Christ Jesus, [born anew] that we may do those good works which God predestined (planned beforehand) for us [taking paths which He prepared ahead of time], that we should walk in them [living the good life which He prearranged and made ready for us to live].

Phil 2:13 → [Not in your own strength] for it is God Who is all the while [a]effectually at work in you [energizing and creating in you the power and desire], both to will and to work for His good pleasure and satisfaction and [b]delight.

I let the Word dwell in me richly. He Who began a good work in me will continue until the day of Christ

Col 3:16 → Let the word [spoken by] Christ (the Messiah) have its home [in your hearts and minds] and dwell in you in [all its] richness, as you teach and admonish and train one another in all insight and intelligence and wisdom [in spiritual things, and as you sing] psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, making melody to God with [His] grace in your hearts.

Phil 1:6 → And I am convinced and sure of this very thing, that He Who began a good work in you will continue until the day of Jesus Christ [right up to the time of His return], developing [that good work] and perfecting and bringing it to full completion in you.

I walk in the favor of the Lord. I am surrounded with favor like a shield. I am blessed and highly favored. The Lord sings over me with joy

Ps 5:12 → For You, Lord, will bless the [uncompromisingly] righteous [him who is upright and in right standing with You]; as with a shield You will surround him with goodwill (pleasure and favor).

Prov 3 → My son, (A)do not forget my teaching, but let your heart (B)keep my commandments; for (C)length of days and years of life and peace they will add to you. Do not let (D)kindness and truth leave you; bind them around your neck, write them on the tablet of your heart. So you will (E)find favor and (F)good repute in the sight of God and man.

Zeph 3:17 → The Lord your God is in the midst of you, a Mighty One, a Savior [Who saves]! He will rejoice over you with joy; He will rest [in silent satisfaction] and in His love He will be

silent and make no mention [of past sins, or even recall them]; He will exult over you with singing.

Ps 119:1-2 1BLESSED (HAPPY, fortunate, to be envied) are the undefiled (the upright, truly sincere, and blameless) in the way [of the revealed will of God], who walk (order their conduct and conversation) in the law of the Lord (the whole of God's revealed will). Blessed (happy, fortunate, to be envied) are they who keep His testimonies, and who seek, inquire for and of Him and crave Him with the whole heart.

Eph1:2-3, 11, 14 2May grace (God's unmerited favor) and spiritual peace [which means peace with God and harmony, unity, and undisturbedness] be yours from God our Father and from the Lord Jesus Christ. 3May blessing (praise, laudation, and eulogy) be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ (the Messiah) Who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual (given by the Holy Spirit) blessing in the heavenly realm!11In Him we also were made [God's] heritage (portion) and we obtained an inheritance; for we had been foreordained (chosen and appointed beforehand) in accordance with His purpose, Who works out everything in agreement with the counsel and design of His [own] will, 14That [Spirit] is the guarantee of our inheritance [the first-fruits, the pledge and foretaste, the down payment on our heritage], in anticipation of its full redemption and our acquiring [complete] possession of it--to the praise of His glory.

Esther 5:2 And when the king saw Esther the queen standing in the court, she obtained favor in his sight, and he held out to [her] the golden scepter that was in his hand. So Esther drew near and touched the tip of the scepter.

Proverbs 14:35 The king's favor is toward a wise and discreet servant, but his wrath is against him who does shamefully.

Matthew 5:10 Blessed and happy and enviably fortunate and spiritually prosperous (in the state in which the born-again child of God enjoys and finds satisfaction in God's favor and salvation, regardless of his outward conditions) are those who are persecuted for righteousness' sake (for being and doing right), for theirs is the kingdom of heaven!

Acts 7:10 And delivered him from all his distressing afflictions and won him goodwill and favor and wisdom and understanding in the sight of Pharaoh, king of Egypt, who made him governor over Egypt and all his house.

I put on the full armor of God to withstand all the attacks of the enemy. Having done all, I stand in His truth. I wait (like a waiter attentive to God's every call .. not like sit back and wait) on the Lord. My weapons are not carnal but are mighty through God to pull down strongholds

Eph 6:10-18 → In conclusion, be strong in the Lord [be empowered through your union with Him]; draw your strength from Him [that strength which His boundless might provides]. Put on God's whole armor [the armor of a heavy-armed soldier which God supplies], that you may be able successfully to stand up against [all] the strategies and the deceits of the devil. For we are not wrestling with flesh and blood [contending only with physical opponents], but against the despotisms, against the powers, against [the master spirits who are] the world rulers of this present darkness, against the spirit forces of wickedness in the heavenly (supernatural) sphere. Therefore put on God's complete armor, that you may be able to resist and stand your ground on the evil day [of danger], and, having done all [the crisis demands], to stand [firmly in your place]. Stand therefore [hold your ground], having tightened the belt of truth around your loins and having put on the breastplate of integrity and of moral rectitude and right standing with God, and having shod your feet in preparation [to face the enemy with the ^[a]firm-footed stability, the promptness, and the readiness ^[b]produced by the good news] of the Gospel of peace.^(B) Lift up over all the [covering] shield of ^[c]saving faith, upon which you can quench all the flaming missiles of the wicked [one]. And take the helmet of salvation and the sword that the Spirit ^[d]wields, which is the Word of God. Pray at all times (on every occasion, in every season) in the Spirit, with all [manner of] prayer and entreaty. To that end keep

alert and watch with strong purpose and perseverance, interceding in behalf of all the saints (God's consecrated people).

I choose to rejoice in the Lord. The joy of the Lord is my strength. I have victory in the name of Jesus and Satan is under my feet.

Neh 8:10 → Then [Ezra] told them, Go your way, eat the fat, drink the sweet drink, and send portions to him for whom nothing is prepared; for this day is holy to our Lord. And be not grieved and depressed, for the joy of the Lord is your strength and stronghold.

Rom 16:20 → And the God of peace will soon crush Satan under your feet. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ (the Messiah) be with you.

I walk in God's wisdom and perfect will. I delight in His Word. His Word is a Light to my path. The Holy Spirit through His Word guides me into all truth, discernment, understanding, and comprehension. Through His promises, I have everything I need for life and Godliness.

Ps 1: 1-3 BLESSED (HAPPY, fortunate, prosperous, and enviable) is the man who walks and lives not in the counsel of the ungodly [following their advice, their plans and purposes], nor stands [submissive and inactive] in the path where sinners walk, nor sits down [to relax and rest] where the scornful [and the mockers] gather. But his delight and desire are in the law of the Lord, and on His law (the precepts, the instructions, the teachings of God) he habitually meditates (ponders and studies) by day and by night.(A) he shall be like a tree firmly planted [and tended] by the streams of water, ready to bring forth its fruit in its season; its leaf also shall not fade or wither; and everything he does shall prosper [and come to maturity].(B)

Ps 119:105 → Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.

2 Peter 1 2-8 → May grace (God's favor) and peace (which is [a]perfect well-being, all necessary good, all spiritual prosperity, and [b]freedom from fears and agitating passions and moral conflicts) be multiplied to you in [the full, personal, [c]precise, and correct] knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord. For His divine power has bestowed upon us all things that [are requisite and suited] to life and godliness, through the [[d]full, personal] knowledge of Him Who called us by and to His own glory and excellence (virtue). By means of these He has bestowed on us His precious and exceedingly great promises, so that through them you may escape [by flight] from the moral decay (rottenness and corruption) that is in the world because of covetousness (lust and greed), and become sharers (partakers) of the divine nature. For this very reason, [e]adding your diligence [to the divine promises], employ every effort in [f]exercising your faith to develop virtue (excellence, resolution, Christian energy), and in [exercising] virtue [develop] knowledge (intelligence), And in [exercising] knowledge [develop] self-control, and in [exercising] self-control [develop] steadfastness (patience, endurance), and in [exercising] steadfastness [develop] godliness (piety), And in [exercising] godliness [develop] brotherly affection, and in [exercising] brotherly affection [develop] Christian love. For as these qualities are yours and increasingly abound in you, they will keep [you] from being idle or unfruitful unto the [[g]full personal] knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ (the Messiah, the Anointed One).

I am the righteousness of Christ. I am accepted in the Beloved. I am not condemned.

Romans 5:9 → Therefore, since we are now justified (acquitted, made righteous, and brought into right relationship with God) by Christ's blood, how much more [certain is it that] we shall be saved by Him from the indignation and wrath of God.

Romans 5:19 → For just as by one man's disobedience (failing to hear, heedlessness, and carelessness) the many were constituted sinners, so by one Man's obedience the many will be constituted righteous (made acceptable to God, brought into right standing with Him).

- Romans 8:30 → And those whom He thus foreordained, He also called; and those whom He called, He also justified (acquitted, made righteous, putting them into right standing with Himself). And those whom He justified, He also glorified [raising them to a heavenly dignity and condition or state of being].
- 1 Corinthians 1:30 → But it is from Him that you have your life in Christ Jesus, Whom God made our Wisdom from God, [revealed to us a knowledge of the divine plan of salvation previously hidden, manifesting itself as] our Righteousness [thus making us upright and putting us in right standing with God], and our Consecration [making us pure and holy], and our Redemption [providing our ransom from eternal penalty for sin].
- 1 Corinthians 6:11 → And such some of you were [once]. But you were washed clean (purified by a complete atonement for sin and made free from the guilt of sin), and you were consecrated (set apart, hallowed), and you were justified [pronounced righteous, by trusting] in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and in the [Holy] Spirit of our God.
- 2 Corinthians 5:21 → For our sake He made Christ [virtually] to be sin Who knew no sin, so that in and through Him we might become [endued with, viewed as being in, and examples of] the righteousness of God [what we ought to be, approved and acceptable and in right relationship with Him, by His goodness].
- Ephesians 1:6 → [So that we might be] to the praise and the commendation of His glorious grace (favor and mercy), which He so freely bestowed on us in the Beloved.
- Romans 8:1 → THEREFORE, [there is] now no condemnation (no adjudging guilty of wrong) for those who are in Christ Jesus, who live [and] walk not after the dictates of the flesh, but after the dictates of the Spirit.

I do not take offense. I walk in forgiveness. I have died to self and now live unto Christ. It is not me who lives but Christ within me.

- Col 3:8 → But now put away and rid yourselves [completely] of all these things: anger, rage, bad feeling toward others, curses and slander, and foulmouthed abuse and shameful utterances from your lips!
- Jesus said in Mark 11:22-26, Have faith in God. For verily I say unto you, That Whoever shall say unto this mountain, Be removed, and be cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he said shall come to pass; he shall have what he said. Therefore I say unto you, What things you desire, when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you shall have them. And when you stand praying, forgive, if you have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses. But if you do not forgive, neither will your Father which is in heaven forgive your trespasses.
- In Matthew 18:21-35, we read: Then came Peter to him, and said, Lord, how oft shall my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? till seven times? Jesus said unto him, I say not unto you, Until seven times: but, Until seventy times seven.
- Therefore is the kingdom of heaven likened unto a certain king, which would take account of his servants. And when he had begun to reckon, one was brought unto him, which owed him ten thousand talents. But forasmuch as he had not to pay, his lord commanded him to be sold, and his wife, and children, and all that he had, and payment to be made. The servant therefore fell down, and worshipped him, saying, Lord, have patience with me, and I will pay you all. Then the lord of that servant was moved with compassion, and loosed him, and forgave him the debt. But the same servant went out, and found one of his fellow servants, which owed him an hundred pence: and he laid hands on him, and took him by the throat, saying, Pay me that you owes. And his fellow servant fell down at his feet, and besought him, saying, Have patience with me, and I will pay you all. And he would not: but went and cast him into prison, till he should pay the debt. So when his fellow servants saw what was done, they were very sorry, and came and told unto their lord all that was done. Then his lord, after that he had called him, said unto him, O you wicked servant, I forgave you all that debt, because you desired me: Should not you also

have had compassion on thy fellow servant, even as I had pity on you? And his lord was wroth, and delivered him to the tormentors, till he should pay all that was due unto him. So likewise shall my heavenly Father do also unto you, if you FROM YOUR HEARTS forgive not every one his brother their trespasses. ...Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you; Matt. 5:44

For in Jesus Christ neither circumcision avails anything, nor uncircumcision; but faith which works by love. Galatians 5:6

Likewise, you husbands, dwell with them according to knowledge, giving honor unto the wife, as unto the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life; that your prayers be not hindered. 1 Peter 3:7

Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, and clamor, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice: And be you kind one to another, tender-hearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake has forgiven you. Ephesians 4:31,32

Be you therefore followers of God, as dear children; And walk in love, as Christ also has loved us, and has given himself for us an offering and a sacrifice to

God for a sweet smelling savior. Ephesians 5:1,2

Forbearing one another, and forgiving one another, if any man have a quarrel against any: even as Christ forgave you, so also do ye. Colossians 3:13

The first step in forgiveness is acknowledging that you've got a problem against someone and **then going to God about it. The sooner we take the necessary steps to let go of bitterness, unforgiveness or any ill-feelings that we have against anyone, the sooner we are going to be** in the will of God. It's not something one can do in our flesh or mind; it's something we do in our heart - our spirit man. We choose to forgive someone from our heart. If we want our sins to be forgiven, we have to forgive others. When our mind reminds us of what others have done to us, we are to cast down those thoughts immediately. If we don't, the devil would be ruling our minds with evil thoughts and ill feelings. Just say, "Satan, that's not my thought; I've forgiven them and I rebuke that thought in Jesus' Name, for it is written in 2 Corinthians 10:4,5, (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;) Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;" Say that out loud.

All thoughts of unforgiveness come from the enemy. Sometimes it seems as though the thoughts come "24-7". To help us, the Scriptures teach us what to do with our thought life in 2 Corinthians 10:4,5, as well as Philippians 4:7,8: And the peace of God, which passes all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. Finally, brethren, what things are true, what things are honest, what things are just, what things are pure, what things are lovely, what things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things.

Walking in the God-kind of love and practicing forgiveness - the genuine and true God-kind of forgiveness can be one of the most difficult things in our lives to practice and maintain. But this should be the area that we are the best in as believers. Easy to do? No. Important to do and practice? Emphatically yes!

A PRAYER OF FORGIVENESS→ Father God, I come to You in the Name of Jesus to make a personal commitment to walk in the God-kind of love. I've made the decision to love and forgive everyone who has spoken or come against me or my loved ones. I refuse to hold any aught, ill feelings, unforgiveness, strife or discord in my life.1 I want my heart always to be pure and perfect before You.2 According to Your written Word, love never fails; perfect love casts out fear; fear has torment; faith works by love, and the greatest of these is love.3 The love of God is shed abroad in my heart by the Holy Ghost.4 Love is the first fruit of the spirit that is to grow and develop in my life.5 Above all, Jesus gave me a new commandment that I love everyone.6 So, Father, in obedience to Your Word, I

make the decision to forgive _____. I choose to follow You by walking in Love, that my prayers will not be hindered.⁷ I forgive him/her/them, because You want me to, and also because You have forgiven me! I refuse to hold a grudge against anyone, lest I be condemned!⁸ In Jesus' Name, I will resist and cast down every yought that Satan tries to bring to me about this matter.⁹ That offense, which I refuse to think or talk about anymore, is now under the blood of Jesus.¹⁰ The subject is closed! God, I ask You to forgive _____. Lay not this sin to their charge.¹¹ Forgive them, for they know not what they've done.¹² Lord, I remind You that You've forgiven me of all my sins, wrongdoings, faults and shortcomings.¹³ Jesus forgave all those who persecuted and crucified Him, as well as those who personally attacked Him. 12 Stephen forgave those who railed against him and stoned him.¹¹ If Jesus could forgive when they were crucifying Him and Stephen could forgive when they were stoning him, I know and believe that I can forgive anyone who has come against me and my loved ones. This is because I can do all things through Christ, Who gives me the strength.¹⁴ Lord, I ask You to bless _____. 15 I purpose in my heart to only do him/her/them good from this day forth: ___/___/____. Jesus said I can have what I say.¹⁶ Therefore, based on the written Word of God,¹⁷ my confession of faith is the following: In the Name of Jesus, I'm not moved by what I see,¹⁸ by what others do to me or say about me, nor by how they treat me. I refuse to be a carnal Christian.¹⁹ I choose to be spiritually mature in the Lord and keep under my flesh.²⁰ If no one else in the body of Christ walks in the God-kind of love, that is none of my business! I know it's my responsibility as a believer to forgive and walk in the God-kind of love, no matter how others conduct themselves. I hold no grudges or resentments against anyone. I refuse to allow my flesh and carnal nature to dominate me. I refuse to be ruled by my emotions or feelings. I walk in the Spirit.²¹ I walk by faith and not by sight,¹⁸ and I always walk in the God-kind of love.²² Because I do, I reap the benefits of long life, good health and divine protection.²³ Everything always works out for my good,²⁴ and whatever I do prospers.²⁵ I don't sit in the seat of the scornful.²⁶ On the contrary, I'm seated with Christ Jesus, ruling and reigning in this life with Him.²⁷ Satan has no place in my life ²⁸ because I have no guile in me.²⁹ I love everyone the same with the God-kind of love. I never return railing for railing or evil for evil, and I'm always quick to forgive and slow to speak.³⁰ I'm not easily provoked, and I think evil of no one because I think on those things that are true, honest, just, pure, lovely, of good report, virtuous and praiseworthy. ³¹ Since I operate my Christian life in the God-kind of love and have forgiven everyone of everything, I'm always blessed with the blessings of the Lord. I refrain my tongue from evil, and my lips speak no guile.³² Therefore, my faith is not hindered. By faith, I believe God has heard and answered my prayers.³³ As it is written, For if our heart condemn us, God is greater than our heart, and knoweth all things. Beloved, if our heart condemn us not, then have we confidence toward God. And what we ask, we receive of him, because we keep his commandments and do those things that are pleasing in his sight. And this is his commandment, that we should believe on The name of his Son Jesus Christ, and love one another, as he gave us commandment. 1 John 3:20 – 23 Thank You, Father God, for always helping me to forgive others and walk in love, in Jesus' Name. Amen.

I will not be moved by anything that disagrees with Your word, even temporary circumstances. Your word is what I will say more than anything else. I will meditate on it day and night.

God, I thank You for Your written Word because it never fails,¹ it never returns void,² and it is alive, quick, and more powerful than any two-edged sword.³ I thank You that You have exalted Your Word above Your Name,⁴ and that You confirm Your Word in my life with signs following.⁵ You hasten Your Word to perform it in my life.⁶ Your Word abides in my heart that I'll not sin against You.⁷ You sent Your Word and healed me and delivered me from all destructions.⁸ The entrance of Your Word brings light ⁹ and dispels the darkness, which is from Satan and his kingdom.

Father God, I meditate upon Your Word day and night. Therefore, I'm always speaking Your Word to mountains, circumstances and situations in my life.¹⁰ I attend to Your Word first; I incline my ears to Your Word, I don't let Your Word depart from my eyes.¹¹ I keep Your Word in my heart, for Your Words are life and health to all my flesh.¹²

I don't let the Word depart from my mouth, so I prosper in all that I do, and I have good success.

¹³ I believe Your Word above everything else that my five physical senses tell me. I am not only a hearer of the Word; I'm a doer also.¹⁴ I always act upon Your Word because it is true.¹⁵

When circumstances arise in my life, I always ask myself, "What does the Word say about this?"

I make sure that every voice that comes to me, or any seemingly supernatural experience, such as prophecies, visions, dreams, angelic appearances, or religious teachings, line up with the written Word of God.¹⁶ And, if any of these contradict the New Testament, I reject them in Jesus' Name, no matter how spectacular they may seem, sound, or appear. I avoid all extreme teachings and manifestations that aren't sound New Testament biblical doctrine.¹⁷ I thank You that You always reveal Your will to me through revelation knowledge of Your Word. I'm going to continue renewing my mind to Your Word by hearing the Word of God and speaking the Word of God out of my mouth.¹⁸ You said in John 8:31,

IF you CONTINUE IN MY WORD, then are you my disciples indeed; God, with the help of the Holy Spirit, Who is the Teacher of the church,¹⁹ I set my will in motion by choosing never to depart from Your Word.²⁰ According to Philippians 4:8, I will judge every voice,

yought or feeling that comes to my mind or emotions by asking myself if what I'm thinking, feeling or seeing is true, honest, just, pure, lovely, of good report, or any virtue or praise.

I'm going to reject and rebuke anything that is contrary to Your Word, in Jesus' Name, according to 2 Corinthians 10:4&5. God, I don't want to be deceived in any area of my life.²¹ Through Your Word, I can distinguish the difference between Satan's voice and the voice of the Holy Spirit. I want all of the instructions and directions that I act upon to be in line with the Word of God.

I don't want anything that I'm believing or doing to contradict the New Testament, which is my covenant with You, God, through Jesus Christ.²² I will search the scriptures daily ²³ to keep my mind renewed with the Word of God, to have my faith fed on the Word of God and to make sure that I'm not getting off on anything that would take me away from You.

I refuse to let any corrupt communication proceed out of my mouth,²⁴ for I choose to speak the Word only.²⁵ I choose not only to hear the Word, but to do the Word. I want all of my prayers to be answered, so I constantly speak the Word, meditate on the Word, and I keep the Word of God abiding in my heart, for Jesus said in John 15:7, If you abide in me, and my words abide in you, you shall ask what you will, and it shall be done unto you. God, I believe Your Word above everything else, because Your Word prevails in my life, and I always put Your Word first.²⁶

So, my confession of faith is, "I am what Your Word says I am, I have what Your Word says I have, and I can do what Your Word says I can do. Be it unto me according to Your Word.²⁷ Because of Your written Word, the Name of Jesus and the power of the Holy Spirit in my life, I'm ruling and reigning in this life in Christ Jesus.²⁸ Thank You , Father God, for Your Holy written Word and the Name of Jesus!

Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Savior Jesus Christ; Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works. Titus 2:13,14
Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that comes unto God by him, seeing he ever lives to make intercession for them. Hebrews 7:25

I make a habit of praising God in all things. You are worthy of all my praise. Praise and thanksgiving are on my lips at all times...

There is none above You and none like You (Ps. 22:3; Ps. 22:23; Ps. 33:21 & Ps. 48:1).
I praise God because He's good and merciful (Ps. 106:1).
I praise the Lord continually and willingly, as a sacrifice unto Him (Hebrews 13:15, Psalm 34:1 & Psalm 54:6).
When I praise God, I show Him that I believe He's heard and answered our prayers (Philippians 4:6, John 6:11 & John 11:41).
Praising God strengthens my faith in Him and His Word (Romans 4:20).
I don't praise the Lord halfheartedly; God wants to hear my praise for Him from my heart, and with my whole heart (Psalm 9:1, Psalm 86:12 & Psalm 111:1).
I praise God with my mouth (Psalm 50:23, Psalm 51:15, Psalm 35:27, 28 & Psalm 19:1-3)
I praise the Lord from the time I first get up, until I lie down at night (Psalm 113:1-3).
Who should praise the Lord? From Kings to children (Psalm 148:11-14). Everything that has breath should praise the Lord (Psalm 150:6).

When we praise God, we show Him that we believe and trust Him and His Word above our present physical circumstances and situations. When in the natural, there was no one to help Jonah out of his dilemma, he called out to God in prayer and began to thank God that he was delivered. God miraculously delivered Jonah (Jonah 2: 1, 9, & 10).

God had mercy upon Jonah and delivered him out of his troubles, even though he had disobeyed the Lord. On the other hand, Paul and Silas had obeyed God, and were severely persecuted for their service unto the Lord. The Bible says in Acts 16: 25 & 26 that their miracle came as they were praising God.

In another instance, a woman who did not have a covenant with God got her demon possessed daughter delivered through her persevering faith and her worship unto the Lord (Matthew 15: 21-28).

After a man with leprosy was healed for obeying the voice of the Lord, he worshiped and thanked the Lord, and he was made whole (Luke 17: 11-19).

Through David's sacrifice of praise and thanksgiving unto the Lord, God delivered him out of trouble on numerous occasions (Psalm 18:3 & 2 Samuel 22:4, 18).

The benefits that you and I receive from praising God are innumerable (Ps. 68:19; Ps.103:2-5; Ps. 107:20-22 & Ps. 112:1-3).

Giving thanks always for all things unto God and the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ; Eph. 5:20

Rejoice in the Lord always: and again I say, Rejoice. Be careful for nothing; but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. Philippians 4:4,6

Giving thanks unto the Father, which has made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light: Who has delivered us from the power of darkness, and has translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son: In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins: Colossians 1:12-14

Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord. And what you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God and the Father by him. Colossians 3:16,17

Rejoice evermore. Pray without ceasing. In everything give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you. 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18

By him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of our lips giving thanks to his name. Hebrews 13:15

But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that you should show forth the praises of him who has called you out of darkness into his marvelous light: 1 Peter 2:9

He shall call upon me, and I will answer him: I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honor him. With long life will I satisfy him, and show him my salvation (Psalm 91:14-16);

But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus (Philippians 4:19);

You protect me from all evil and harm, and You keep me from falling.⁵ & 12 You lead me by the Holy Spirit. You enlighten me and encourage me through Your Word¹³ and reveal Your perfect will to me.¹⁴ You sustain me daily¹⁵ and abundantly supply all of my needs and desires, ¹⁶ for You said in Ephesians 3:20 : Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us.

I thank You, Father God, for protecting me today and for leading me by Your Holy Spirit. I thank You for giving me wisdom in every situation, favor with every person, strength for every task, and discernment to know right from wrong. I thank You that the Holy Spirit gives me revelation knowledge from Your Word.

Anoint me to be a witness and help me to flow in the Holy Ghost and have the gifts of the Holy Spirit operate through me. Make me a blessing to whomever I come in contact with today. I thank You, Father God, that You're good and our mercy endures forever, in Jesus' Name, Amen.

For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that, he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, that you through his poverty might be rich. 2 Corinthians 8:9

He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things? Romans 8:32

According as his divine power has given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that has called us to glory and virtue: 2 Peter 1:3

I don't want to be controlled or dominated by my flesh, mind or carnal nature, or live in guilt or condemnation, constantly having to repent for the same thing over and over again. Instead, I want to be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. I don't want anything in my life to displease You or to grieve the Holy Spirit.

I want my light to shine and for people to see Jesus in my life. I want to live in the liberty of the Lord and not be in bondage to my flesh, the lusts of the world, or to Satan or any of his

evil forces. Jesus said, ...the spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak (Matthew 26:41).

I thank You for helping me to be strong in the spirit so I can overcome the weaknesses of the flesh. Thank You for helping me be a doer of the Word of God and for helping me to do those things that are pleasing in Your sight.

Thank You, Father God, for delivering me from _____ and for helping me never to go back to the world, the dictates of my flesh, or what I am delivered from. I don't want to be a servant to sin, or for sin to reign over my mortal body that I should obey the lusts thereof. I want to walk in the light and not in darkness, righteousness and not unrighteousness, freedom and not bondage, peace and not torment, holiness and not ungodliness, and humility and not pride. I want to live in Your protection and blessings without exposing myself to the curse of the law (Proverbs 26:2), which includes sickness, disease, poverty and lack. I refuse to give the devil any place in my life (Ephesians 4:27).

Father, You said in 1 Corinthians 10:13, There has no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that you are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that you may be able to bear it.

Hebrews 12:1, 2: Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us, Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.

James 1:12: Blessed is the man that endures temptation: for when he is tried, he shall receive the crown of life, which the Lord has promised to them that love him.

Romans 12:1, 2: I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. And be not conformed to this world: but be you transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

So I thank You, Father God, that You are in my life and that You love and care for me. Thank You for helping me walk in Your perfect will and for giving me the strength to overcome my flesh and the temptations of the world. I thank You for giving me the authority to resist the devil in Jesus' Name, Amen.

Philippians 4:6: Be careful for nothing; but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.

1 Timothy 2:8: I will therefore that men pray everywhere, lifting up holy hands, without wrath and doubting.

Hebrews 13:15: By him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of our lips giving thanks to his name.

Romans 8:1, 2, 5-8, 13: There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death. For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit. For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.

Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be. So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God. For if you live after the flesh, you shall die: but if you through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, you shall live.

Romans 6:23: For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

- 1 Corinthians 3:16: Know you not that you are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwells in you? 17If any man defile the temple of God, him shall God destroy; for the temple of God is holy, which temple you are.
- 1 Corinthians 6:9-12; 15-20: Know you not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind, 10Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortionists, shall inherit the kingdom of God. 11And such were some of you: but you are washed, but ye are sanctified, but you are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God. 12All things are lawful unto me, but all things are not expedient: all things are lawful for me, but I will not be brought under the power of any. 15Know you not that your bodies are the members of Christ? shall I then take the members of Christ, and make them the members of an harlot? God forbid. 16What? know you not that he which is joined to an harlot is one body? for two, said he, shall be one flesh. 17But he that is joined unto the Lord is one spirit. 18Flee fornication. Every sin that a man doeth is without the body; but he that commits fornication sinned against his own body. 19What? know you not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which you have of God, and you are not your own? 20For you are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.
- 2 Corinthians 6:14-18: Be you not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship has righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion has light with darkness? 15And what concord has Christ with Belial? or what part has he that believeth with an infidel? 16And what agreement has the temple of God with idols? for you are the temple of the living God; as God has said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people. 17Wherefore come out from among them, and be you separate, said the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you, 18And will be a Father unto you, and you shall be my sons and daughters, said the Lord Almighty.
- Galatians 5:14-25: For all the law is fulfilled in one word, even in this; You shall love thy neighbor as thyself. 15But if you bite and devour one another, take heed that you be not consumed one of another. 16This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh. 17For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh: and these are contrary the one to the other: so that you cannot do the things that you would. 18But if you be led of the Spirit, you are not under the law. 19Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, 20Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies, 21Envyings, murders, drunkenness, reveling, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God. 22But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, 23Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law. 24And they that are Christ's have crucified the flesh with the affections and lusts. 25If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit.
- Philippians 4:7, 8: And the peace of God, which passes all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. 8Finally, brethren, what things are true, what things are honest, what things are just, what things are pure, what things are lovely, what things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things.
